

## NTSAD's 46th Annual Family Conference

National Tay-Sachs & Allied Diseases Association (NTSAD) is one of the oldest patient advocacy organizations in the country serving families and individuals coping with a diagnosis of Tay-Sachs, Canavan, GM1 gangliosidosis, and Sandhoff diseases.

Since 1978, NTSAD has hosted the Annual Family Conference to provide families a safe space to support and learn from one another, to gain knowledge directly from researchers and industry members working on potential therapies, and to contribute and share their experiences to further enhance the development of clinical trials.
