


NTSAD's Annual Family Conference

Since 1978, NTSAD has presented the Annual Family Conference to provide families a safe space to support and learn from one another, to gain knowledge directly from researchers and industry members working on potential therapies, and to contribute and share their experiences to further enhance the development of clinical trials. Highlights from the 2023 Conference, included:



- More than **300 people** attended.
- **78+ families** who hailed from the U.S., Canada, and as far away as Argentina attended the event.





- Research Day featured presentations by 24 researchers and industry members from 18 academic institutions and biotech companies.
- 19 conference sessions were facilitated for families and individuals.
- An **Industry Roundtable** focused on best-in-class relationships among patient advocacy organizations, academic medical centers, and industry.
- A Scientific Symposium was held to discuss gene editing.
- **Camp Snuggle** and **Camp Active** provided one-of-a-kind experiences, playtime, and connection for affected children.
- The **Quiet Reflection** and **Commemoration** ceremonies honored loved ones in personal and meaningful ways.
